**Dress Guidelines** Now that the weather is getting warmer we want to remind parents of the NCS Dress Guidelines.

No bare midriffs, no undergarments showing, no spaghetti strap tops or dresses – straps should be a minimum of 2’ wide; no short shorts – shorts should not be shorter than arm length to the fingertips; no clothing that contains inappropriate graphics or messages; no flip-flop sandals that leave most of the foot exposed; high heeled shoes are strongly discouraged; no sagging pants that expose underwear.

The school will inform parents in the event that a student’s dress is not appropriate for school. They will be asked to either take the child home to change or bring them a change of clothes.
