Be sure to save the date for this year's OPEN HOUSE – Wednesday May 27<sup>th</sup>. The Book Fair will also be open for this event.

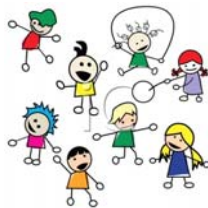
## State Testing
