Dress Guidelines

Now that the weather is getting warmer we want to remind parents of the NCS Dress Guidelines.

No bare midriffs, no undergarments showing, no spaghetti strap tops or dresses – straps should be a minimum of 2' wide; no short shorts – shorts should not be shorter than
