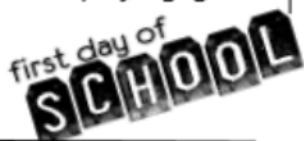

Don't miss Nord Country School's Back to School Night.

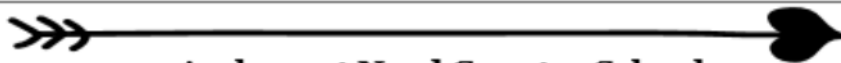
It is a perfect opportunity to meet your child's teacher, hear about their plans for the school year and find out how you can be involved in your child's education.
