Please put your child's name in his or her cool weather clothing. With the warm afternoons they are more likely to be taken off and lost.

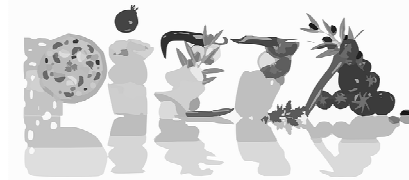
The Lost and Found is located in the cafeteria. Please check it out every so often.
