## CAASPP Test Information

If you have students in grades 3 – 8, you should have recently received the results of your student's California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) testing. These are the tests our students took last spring.

The CAASPP report will show an overall score for your student in each subject. This score shows if your student met, did not meet or exceeded expectations for their grade. The second page of the report includes a further breakdown of that score, providing individualized information on your student's academic strengths and potential challenges. The report will also compare your student's results from last spring's test to his/her results in previous grades, if available.
