

Background:

Toward the end of each school year, students in third through eighth grade take the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP). This assessment measures students in language arts and mathematics. In normal years, this assessment is state mandated. A state science test is also given to 5th and 8th graders every May. Scores for this assessment are not available yet.

Information:

In the 2020-2021 school year, Nord Country School had 113 students, in grades three through eight, take the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress. Due to Covid-19, testing was not required and the test was a shortened version of the normal assessment. Due to this assessment being modified the scores will not be comparable to past years. We, at Nord Country School, chose to have students take the shortened version of the assessment so that we would have data for our Charter renewal (which ended up being postponed).

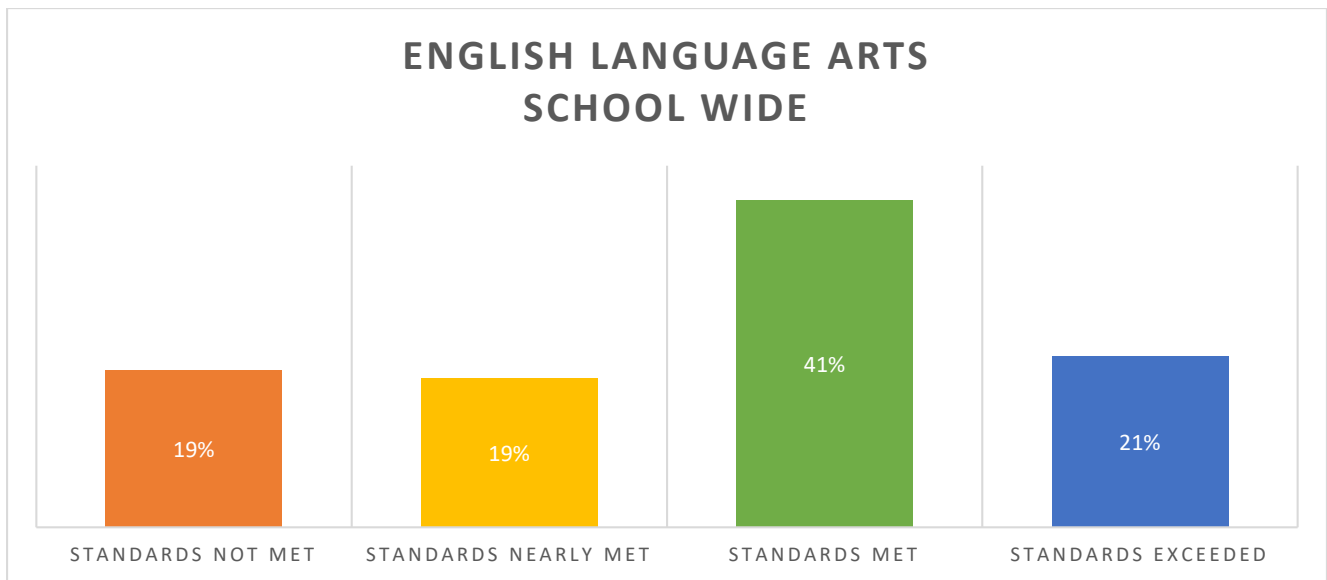

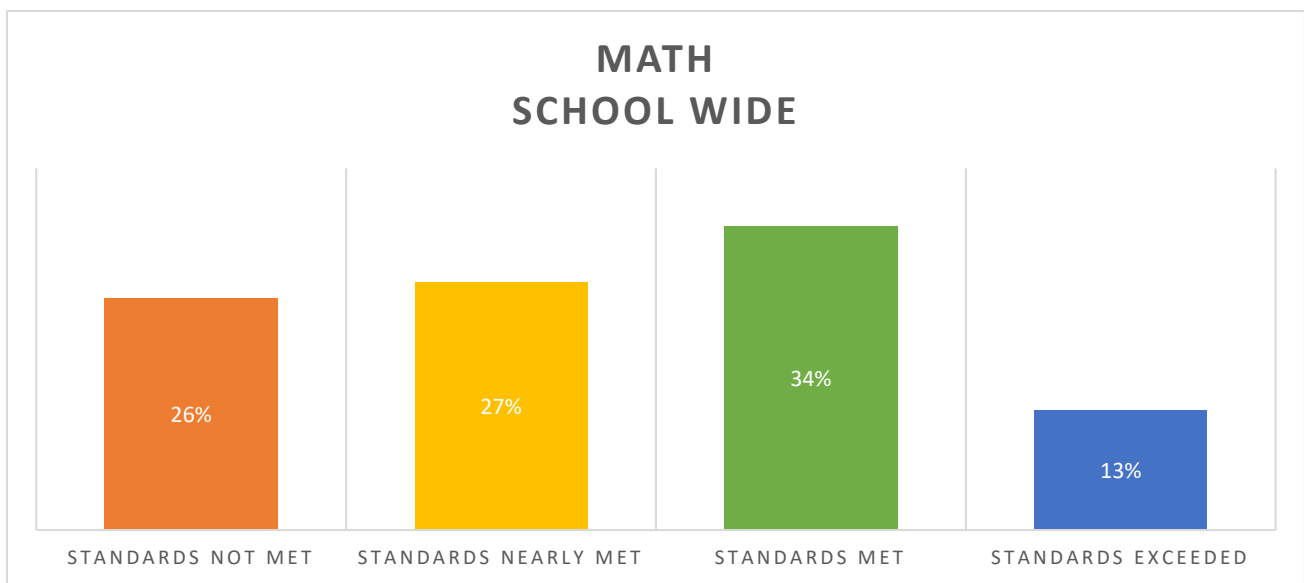

Overall

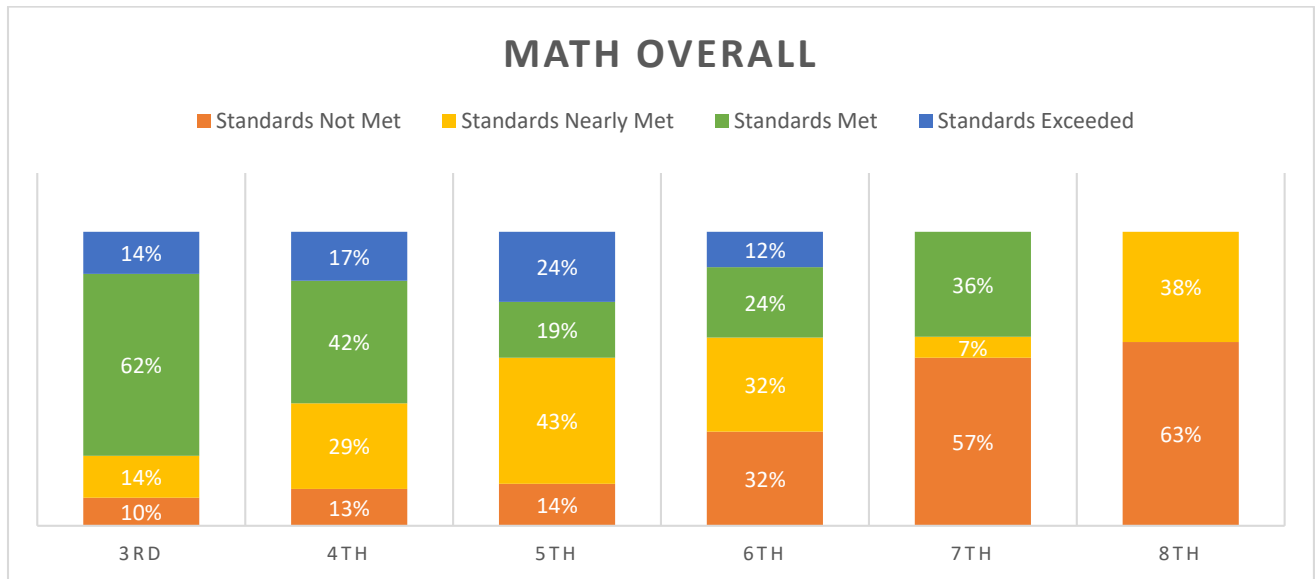
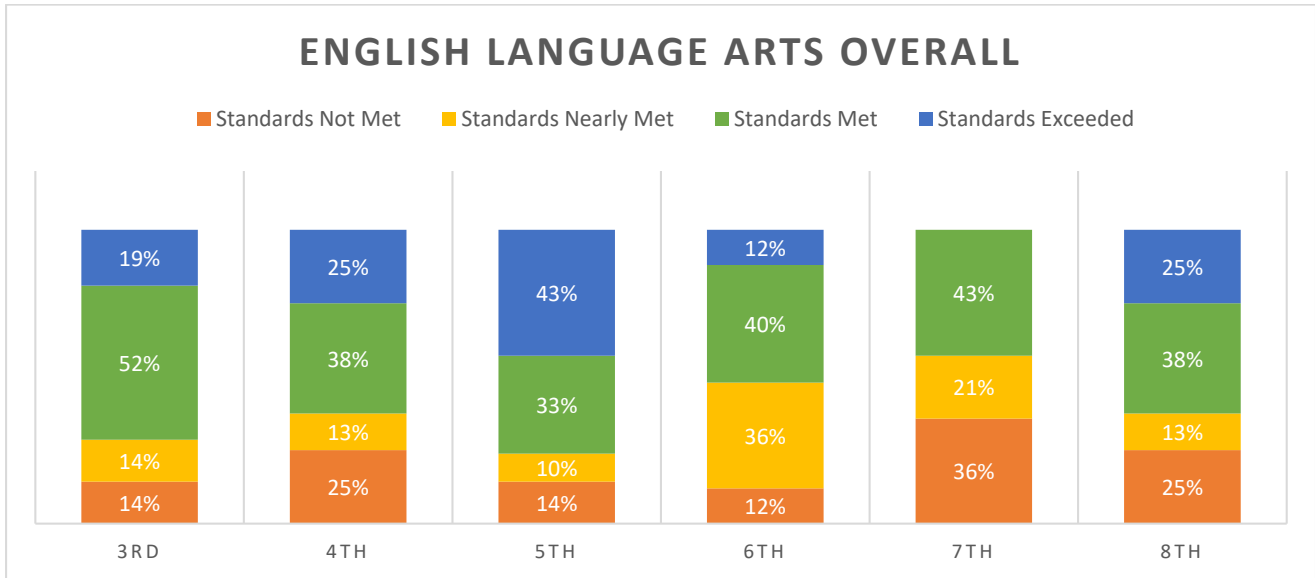


In language arts, 62% of students met or exceeded grade level standards. 19% nearly met the standards and another 19% did not meet the grade level standards.



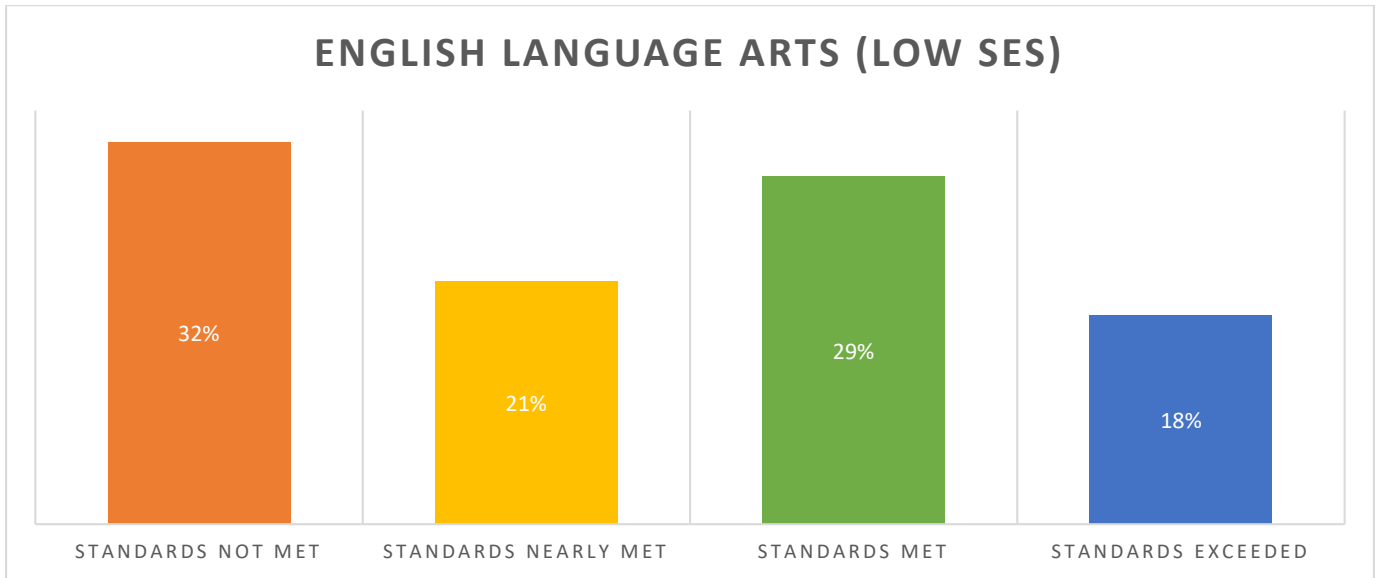
In math, 47% of students met or exceeded grade level standards. 27% nearly met the standards and 26% did not meet the grade level standards.

Overall by Grade

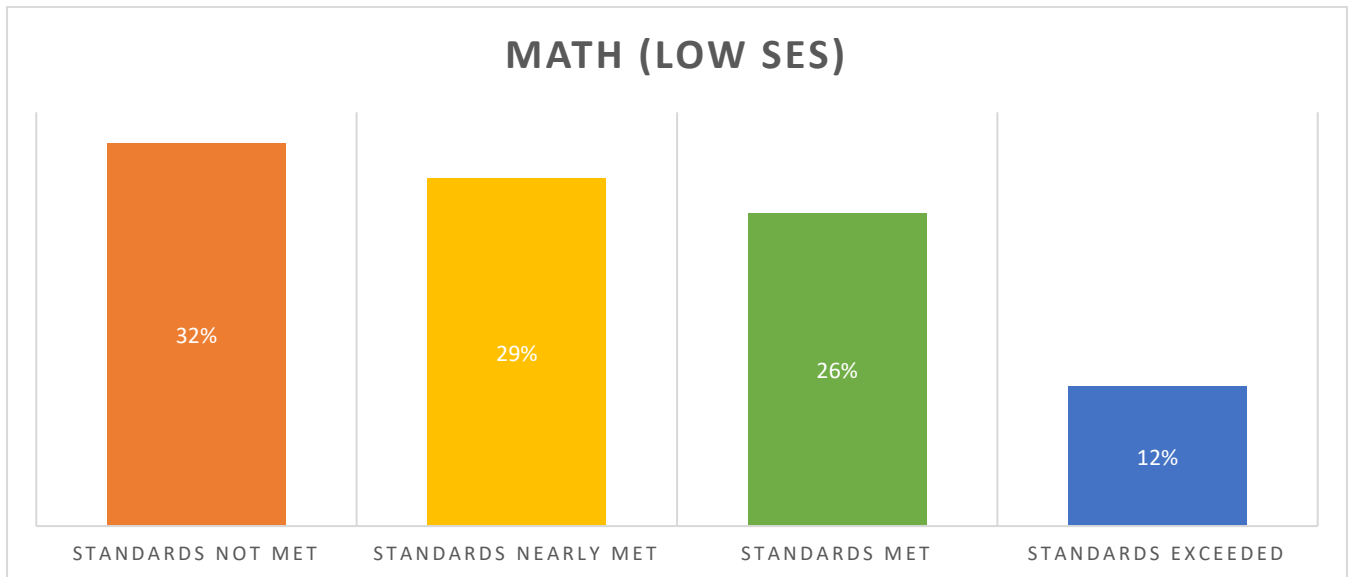


Low SES

We had 34 students who are designated as Low Socioeconomic Status. In English Language Arts, 47% of these students met or exceeded grade level standards. 21% nearly met the standards and 32% did not meet the grade level standards.

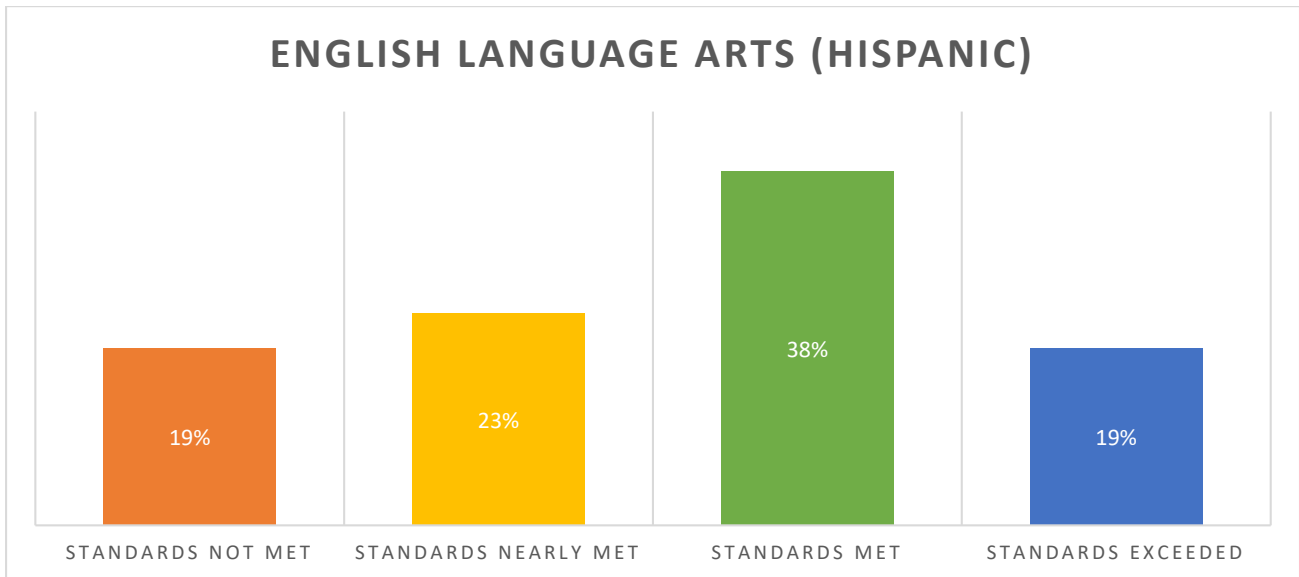


In math, 38% of these students met or exceeded the grade level standards. 29% of the students nearly met the standards and 32% of these students did not meet the grade level standards.

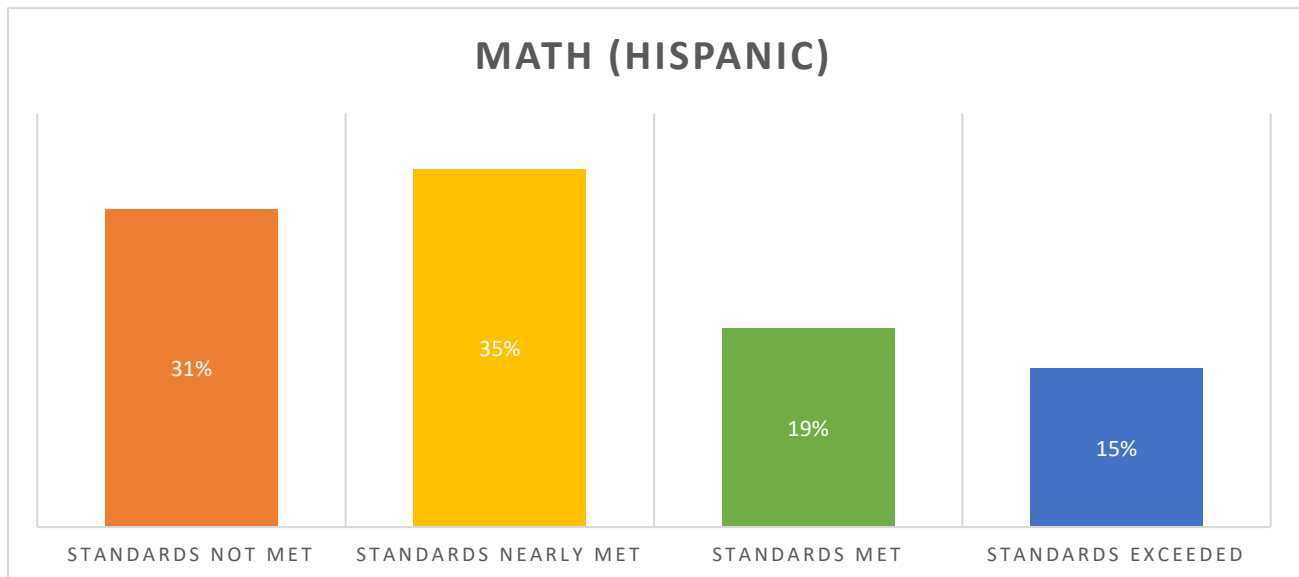


Hispanic

We had 26 students who tested. 57% of these students met or exceeded the grade level standards in English Language Arts. 23% of the students nearly met the grade level standards and 19% did not meet the standards.

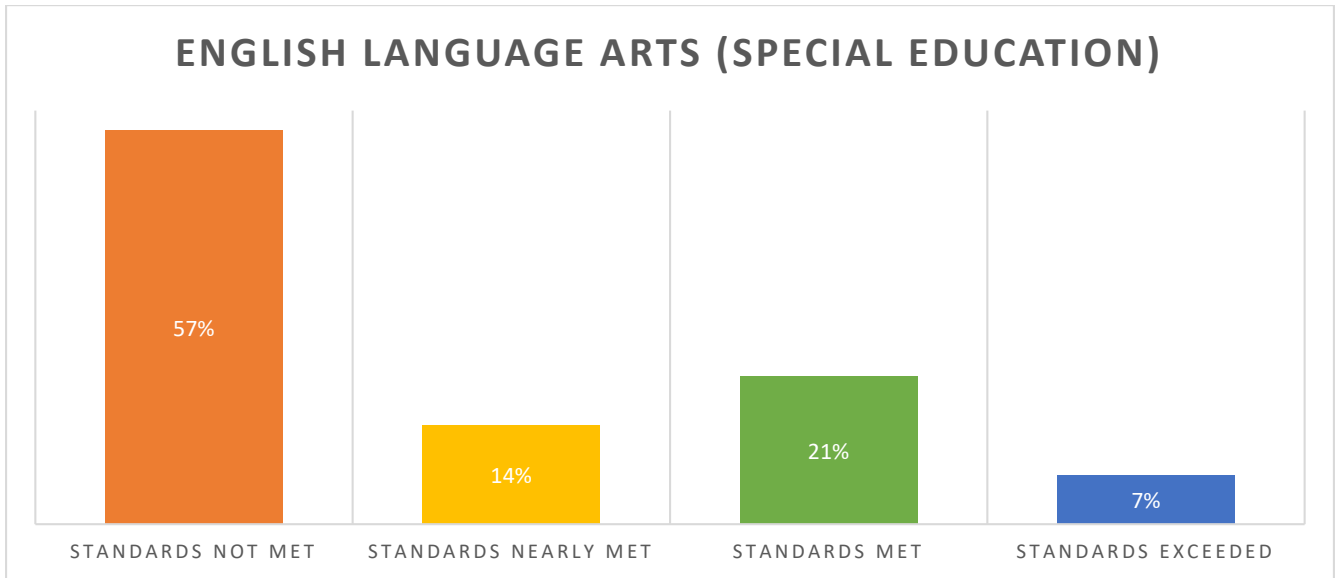


In math, 34% of students met or exceeded the grade level standards, 35% nearly met the standard and 31% did not meet the standard.

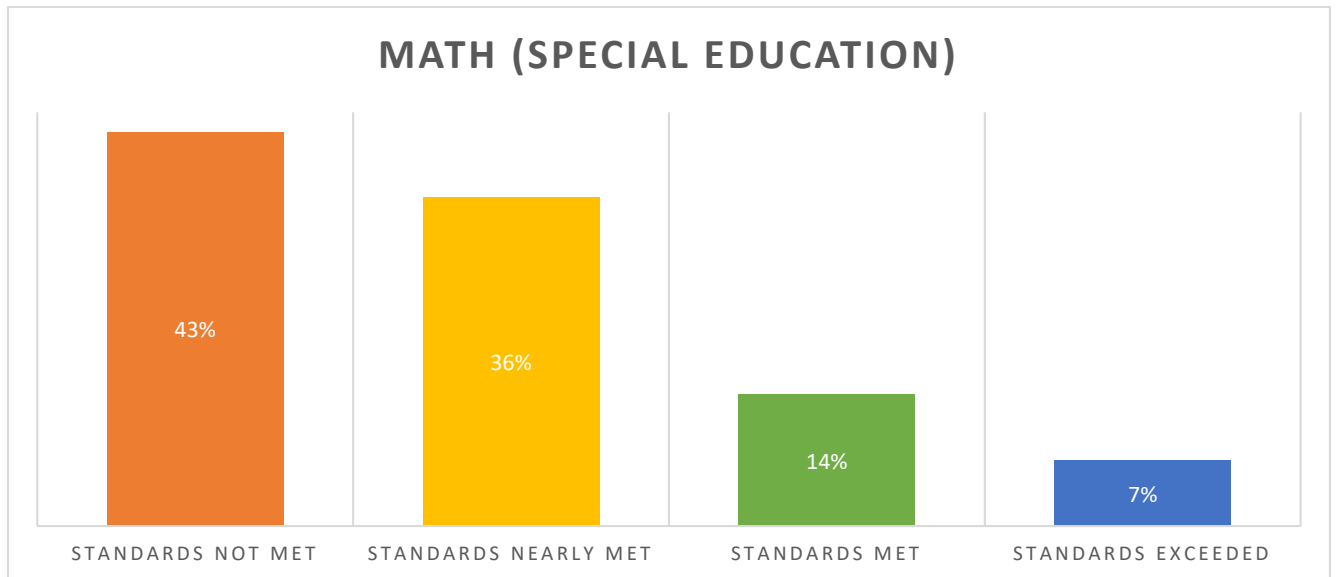


Special Education

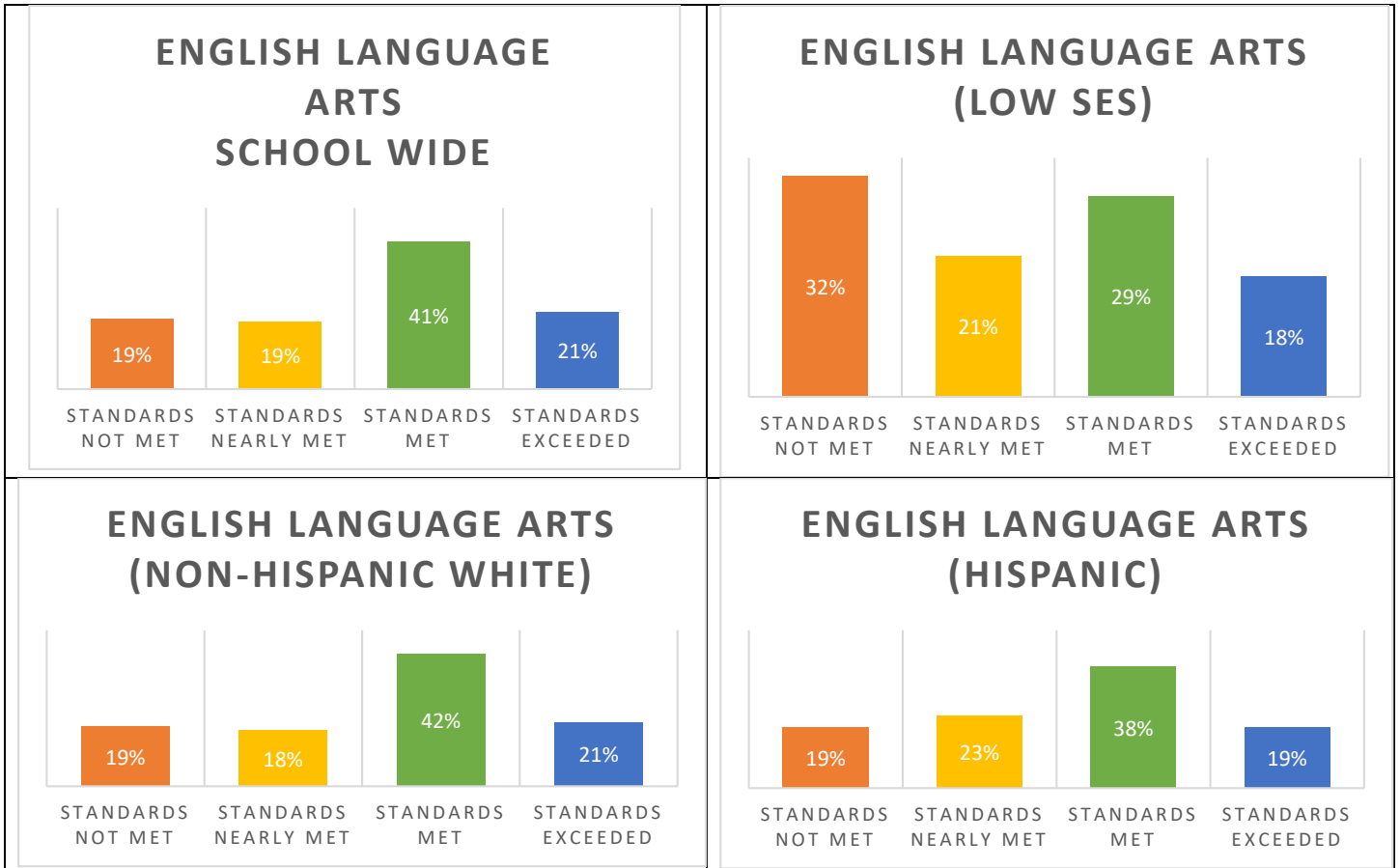
We had 14 students who tested. 28% of them met or exceeded the grade level standards. 14% nearly met the standard and 57% did not meet the grade level standards.
